


Guidelines for the General Public and Businesses to Maximize Public Health and Economic Reactivation” (“Guidelines”), and any subsequent modification to the Guidelines released by the Utah Department of Health during the effective period of this Public Health Order. Section 3. Face Coverings Mandatory. Any individual within Salt Lake County who is age two and over and able to medically or psychologically tolerate a face covering shall be required to wear a face covering that completely covers the nose and mouth when in any public area, including outdoors, when non-household members are present and social distancing is not possible. Section 4. This Public Health Order takes immediate effect and rescinds all prior Public Health Orders related to COVID-19. It will expire at 11:59 p.m. on January 5, 2021 unless extended, rescinded, superseded, or amended in writing, and shall be re-evaluated as warranted.
